



Act Fast, Save Lives: Free NaloxBox (Narcan) available in your neighborhood!

What is a NaloxBox?

NaloxBox refers to a container to hold naloxone kits in public spaces that are accessible 24 hours a day for Naloxone pick up at any location with no personal interaction required.

Why should one carry naloxone?

- Emergency preparedness
- Rapid response
- To support friends and family who may misuse opioids
- Unexpected overdose
- Public health Responsibility

What is Naloxone?

Naloxone is a medication that can reverse an opioid overdose act by blocking opioid receptors in the brain. Naloxone can reverse opioid overdose in 3 to 5 minutes and lasts for 30 to 90 minutes.

Narcan is not dangerous if administered to a person who is not overdosing and has no potential for abuse. It is safe around children.

Anyone could keep naloxone, administer it to a person who is suffering an overdose, and potentially rescue lives.

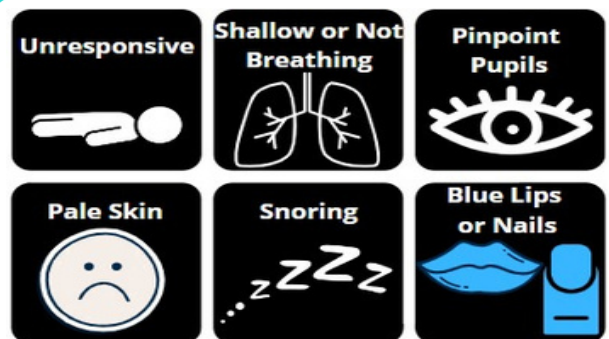
Naloxone has a shelf life of about 2 years. Even expired naloxone may still be effective enough to save lives and will not hurt anyone if you use it.



Aaron's Law protects an individual from civil liability for administering naloxone, so long as they “act in good faith,” do not display “gross negligence or willful misconduct,” and they “attempt to summon” EMS.

Naloxone does not require a prescription and can be administered by anyone to someone that is experiencing an opioid overdose.
